## What's New NEET 2022

- Age Eligibility Criteria Revised for NEET 2022: NTA has scrapped the upper age limit of 25 years for NEET 2022.
- ✓ NEET 2022 Revised Exam Pattern: Each section of the NEET 2022 paper will comprise two sections A and B. Section A will have 35 questions and section B will be having 15 questions and from section B, students will be required to answer any 10 questions. So, the paper will consist of a total number of 200 questions out of which, only 180 questions are to be answered.
- ✓ Increase In Time Duration: There will be extra 20 minutes available for students to solve the NEET 2022 question paper.
- ✓ Increase in Application Fee: There is an increment of rs 100 in the application fee for General, SC/ST/OBC categories. However, for NRI, the fee is 8500 INR which was 7500 INR last year.
- ✓ Seat Reservation through NEET 2022: The National Medical Commission has reserved the seats of the All-India Quota for 15 % and of State Quota Seats for 85% for NEET 2022.
- ✓ Increase in exam centers for NEET 2022: The authority has increased the exam centers to 543 cities in India and 14 abroad for NEET 2022.

## Pattern of the Test

The Test pattern of NEET (UG) - 2022 comprises four Subjects. Each subject will consist of two sections. Section A will consist of 35 Questions and Section B will have 15 Questions, out of these 15 Questions, candidates can choose to attempt any 10 Questions. So, the total number of questions and utilization of time will remain the same. The pattern for the NEET (UG) - 2022 Examination for admission in the Session 2022-23 is as follows:

Note: Correct option marked will be given (4) marks and Incorrect option marked will be minus one (-1) mark. Unattempted/Unanswered Questions will be given no marks.

# **Important Points to Note:**

- (a) For Section A (MCQs): To answer a question, the candidates need to choose one option corresponding to the correct answer or the most appropriate answer. However, if any anomaly or discrepancy is found after the process of challenges of the key verification, it shall be addressed in the following manner:
  - Correct answer or the most appropriate answer: Four marks (+4)
  - Any incorrect option marked will be given minus one mark (-1).
  - Unanswered/Marked for Review will be given no mark (0).
  - If more than one option is found to be correct then Four marks (+4) will be awarded to only those who have marked any of the correct options.
  - If all options are found to be correct then Four marks (+4) will be awarded to all those who have attempted the question.
  - If none of the options is found correct or a Question is found to be wrong or a Question is dropped then all candidates who have appeared will be given four marks (+4) irrespective of the fact whether the question has been attempted or not attempted by the candidate.
- (b) For Section B (MCQs): Candidates need to attempt any 10 Questions out of 15 Questions given. In the event of a candidate has attempted more than 10 questions, only the first 10 attempted questions will be considered for evaluation. There will also be negative marking for Section B. However, if any anomaly or discrepancy is found after the process of challenges of the key verification, it shall be addressed in the following manner:
  - Correct Answer: Four marks (+4)
  - Incorrect Answer: Minus one mark (-1)
  - Unanswered/Marked for Review: No mark (0).
  - If more than one option is found to be correct then Four marks (+4) will be awarded to only those who have marked any of the correct options.
  - If all options are found to be correct then Four marks (+4) will be awarded to all those who have attempted the question.
  - If a question is found to be incorrect or the Question is dropped then Four marks (+4) will be

awarded to all those who have attempted the question. The reason could be due to human error or technical error.

• Candidates are advised to do the calculations with the constants given (if any) in the questions.

## **Duration of Test:**

The duration of the test would be **three (03)** hours and 20 minutes.

## **NEET 2022 Eligibility**

#### Age Criterion:

- The candidates who have completed 17 years or will complete 17 years on December 31st, 2022 are eligible to appear for the NEET 2022.
- The National Medical Commission has removed the upper age limit of 25 years for applying for NEET 2022.
- The conducting authority National Testing Agency has removed the number of attempts for NEET 2022.

#### **Educational Qualification**

- The candidates must have passed a 10+2 or equivalent examination from a recognized board with 50 % with Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and English as compulsory subjects for General candidates to be eligible for NEET 2022.
- The candidates must have passed a 10+2 or equivalent examination from a recognized board with 40 % with Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and English as a compulsory subject for Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe, PwD candidates to be eligible for NEET 2022.

#### **Nationality**

- The applicants must be citizens of India to appear for the NEET 2022 examination.
- The Foreign Nationals, Non-Resident Indian (NRI), Overseas Citizens of India, and PIO are also eligible to appear for the NEET examination.

#### **Total Attempts**

- The conducting authority National Testing Agency has not set the number of limits for candidates to appear for NEET.
- If the applicants fulfill the age criterion of 17 years of age and other eligibility criteria, he/ she can appear for the NEET 2022.

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## <u>NEET Syllabus</u>

- <u>NEET 2022 Physics syllabus</u> comprises of questions from classes 11th & 12th and the overall weightage from the Physics section is 25 %.
- NEET 2022 Chemistry syllabus comprise questions of class 11th & 12th of 14 and 16 units respectively and the overall weightage from the Chemistry section is 25 %.
- NEET Biology syllabus 2022 comprise questions from class 11th & 12th of Zoology and Botany respectively and the overall weightage from the Chemistry section is 50 %.

## **NEET Merit List**

The authority will release the merit list of NEET after the release of the **final answer key**. The National Testing Agency will provide the merit list to the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) which is the counseling body of NEET. The merit list of NEET will be prepared based on the total marks scored by the candidates. The National Testing Agency released three types of **NEET Merit List** which is mentioned in the tabular form below.
